Please mark your calendars for our upcoming Morning Meet Up on October 24 at 8 a.m.

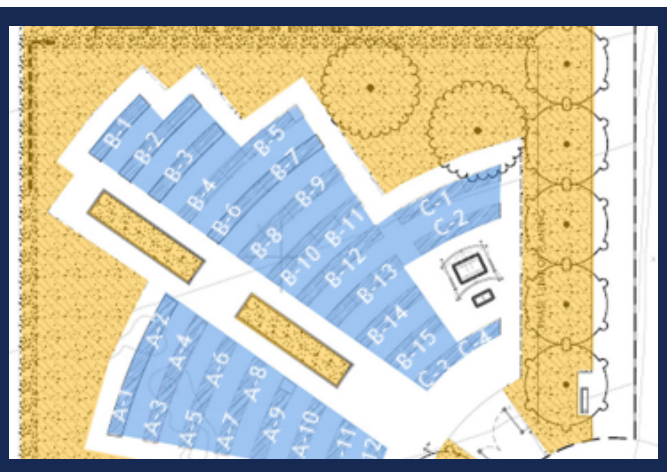
We will be gathering at Coo Coo's Cafe, conveniently located at 19 West Pacific Avenue. We look forward to seeing you there!
