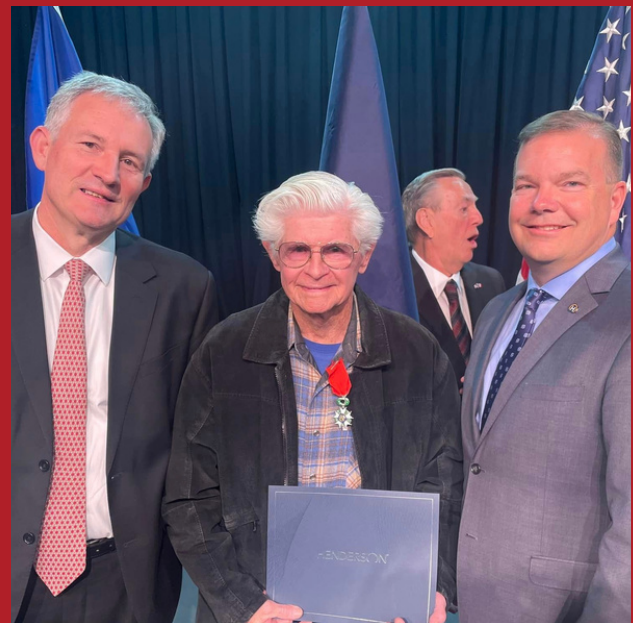
Christmas Luncheon at Art Espinoza Terrace Senior Living Complex

City of Henderson Seeks Developer for Fiesta Henderson Site



Following a 30-day public comment period about the former 35-acre Fiesta Henderson site, purchased in 2022, the City opened a Requests For Qualifications (RFQ) period to select a developer who can help bring the vision of the property to life in a public-private partnership. Resident surveys and feedback resulted in the following community preferences for the site:

- tournament sports facility
- family-oriented entertainment
- arts and culture
- diverse array of public spaces and a wide variety of options to support this site as a “destination.”
