- Perimeter air monitoring equipment was installed in April 2024
- Asbestos cleanup began in May 2024 and will be ongoing through August 2024
- Tailings cleanup began in June 2024 and is scheduled to be completed in December 2024
- The cleanup of waste rock started in July 2024 and is scheduled to be completed in December 2026
