## Landsman Garden Holiday Party



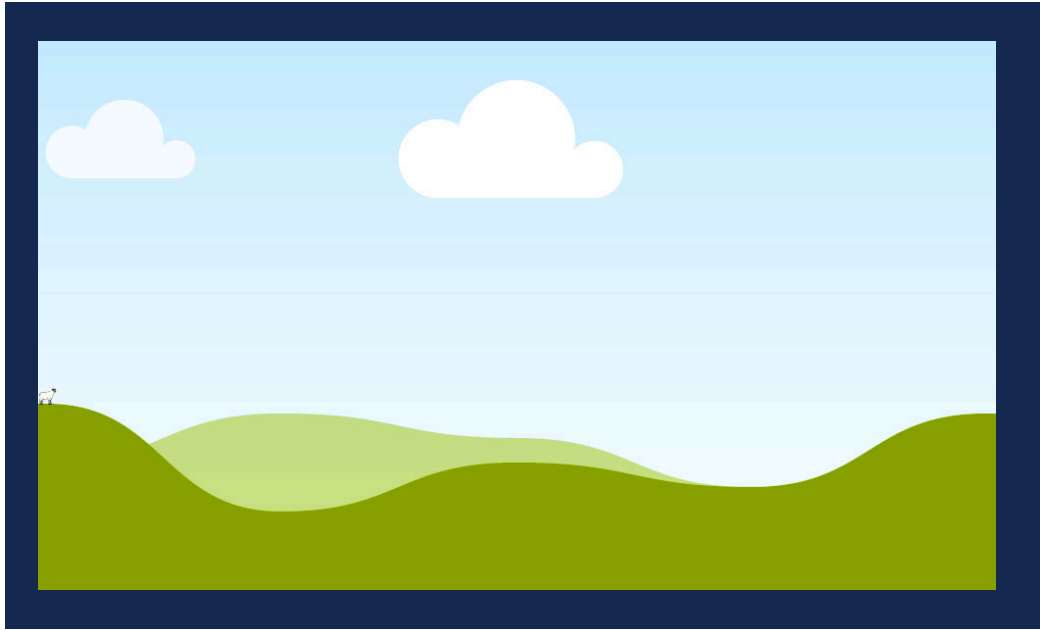
I had the opportunity to attend the holiday party at Landsman Gardens today. Thank you to the folks at the Housing Authority for the invitation.
