Community Open House



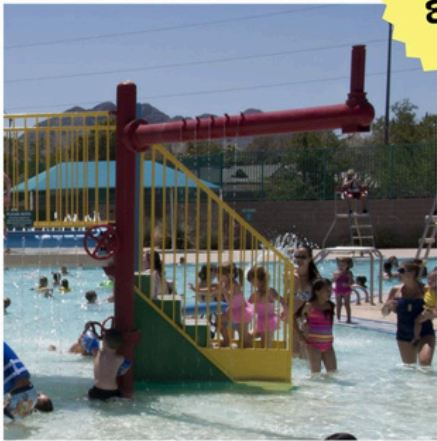

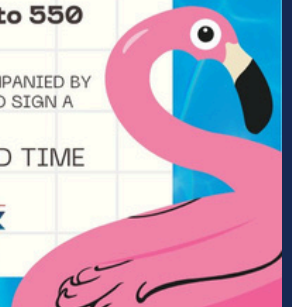
