Hispanic Heritage Short Films

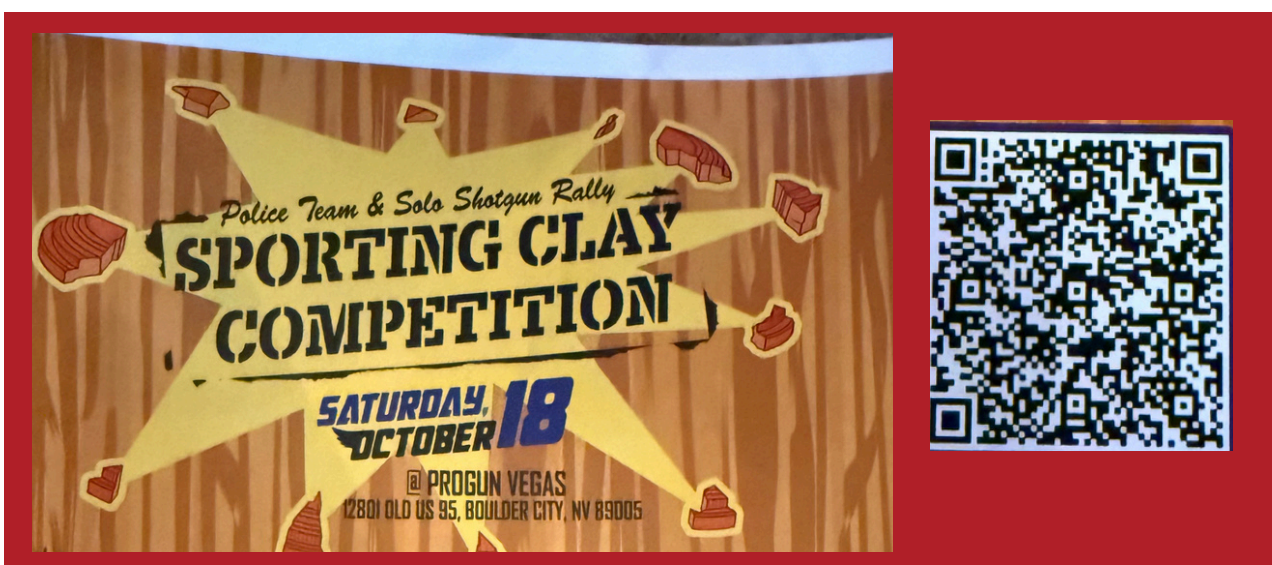

Police Team Sporting Clay Competition



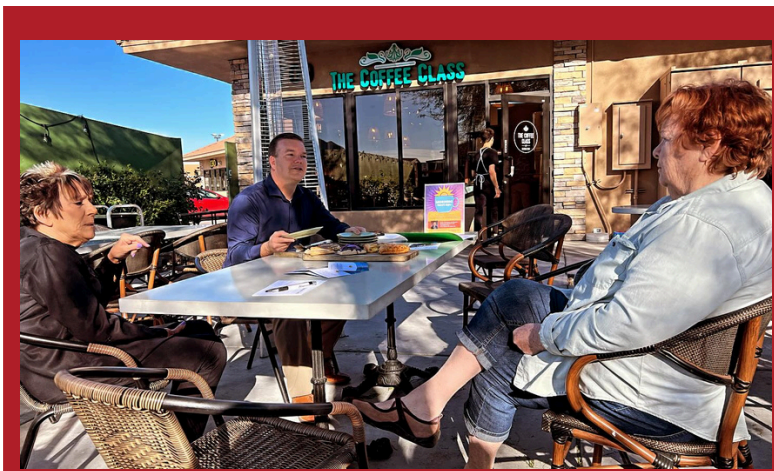
