## Support for Governor Joe Lombardo & Sherriff Kevin McMahon



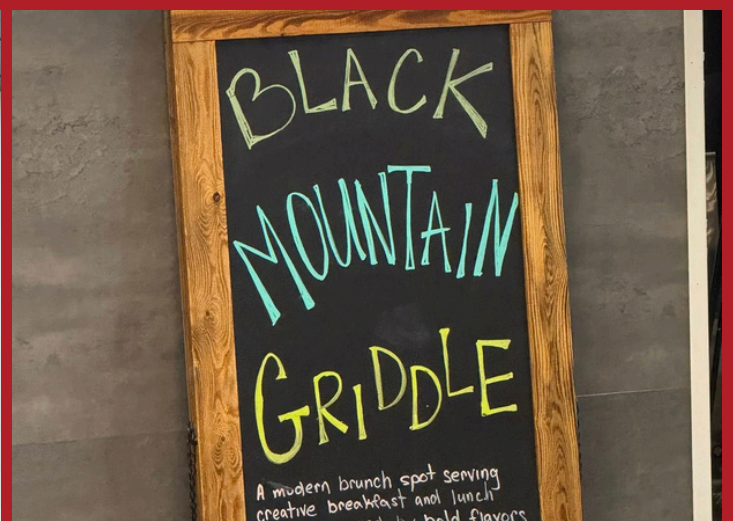
