Vegas Golden Knights Watch Party



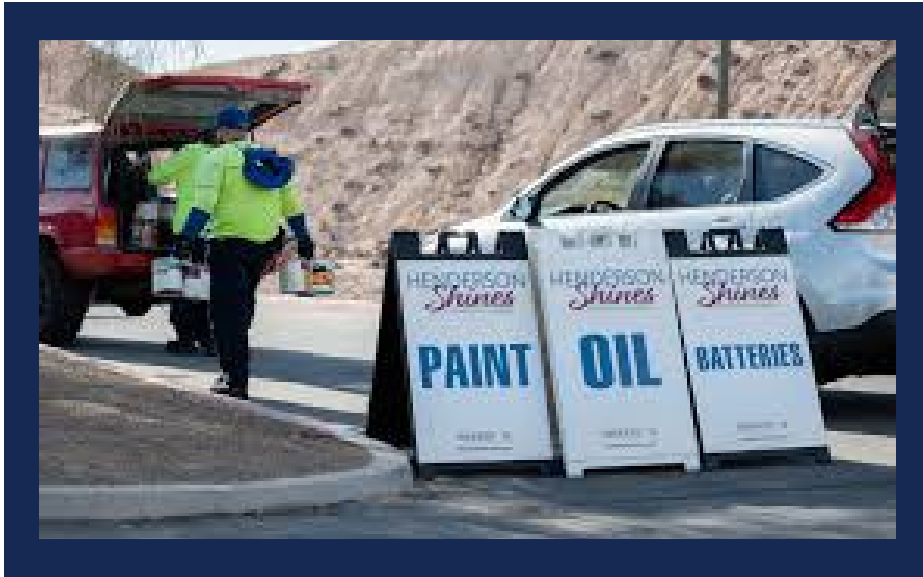
