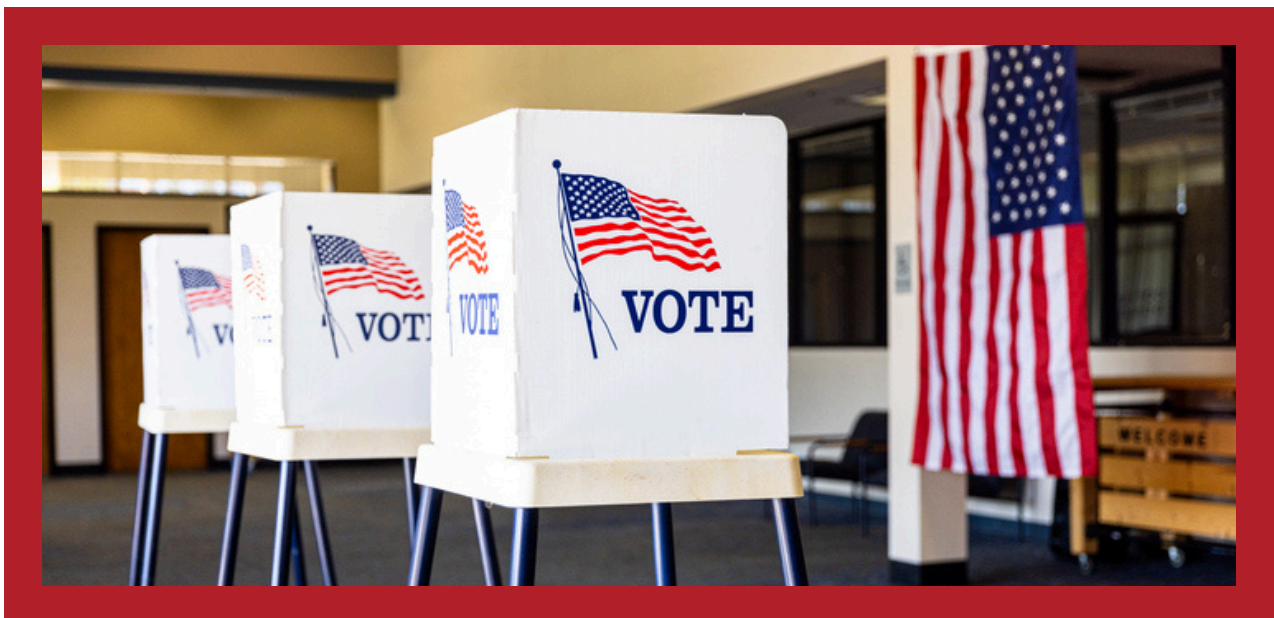

Ballot drop-off will be accepted at the City Hall vote center from 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. from June 1-8, and from 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. on Election Day. In person voting will be available at City Hall from 8:00 a.m.- 5:00 p.m. from June 1-5, and from 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. on June 9. At the Heritage Park Senior Facility, in person voting will be available on June 3 and 4 from 9:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m., on June 5 from 9:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m., and on June 9 from 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.
