## Hispanic Heritage Night



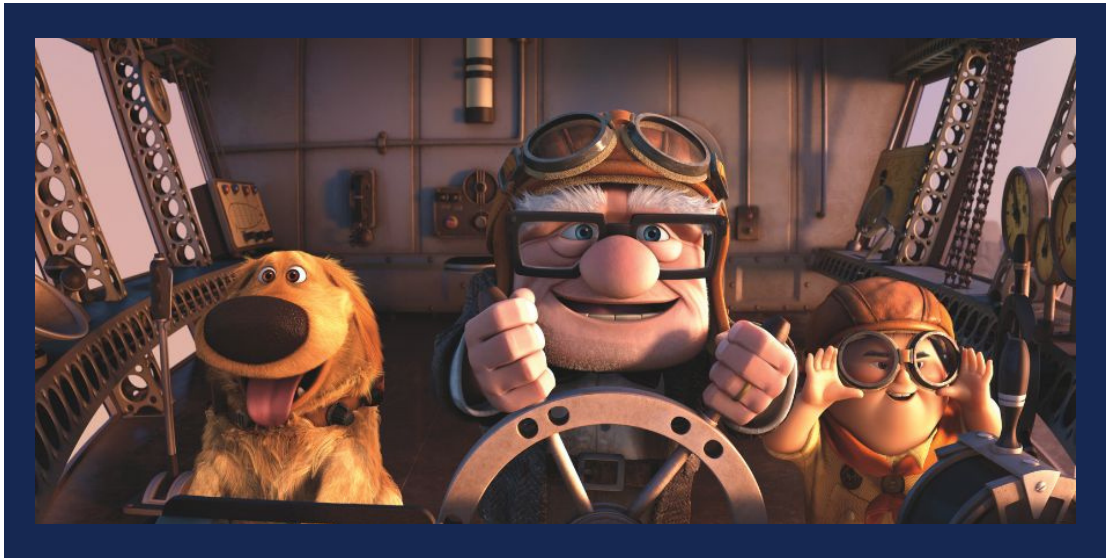
